THE SLIPPERY SALAMANDER



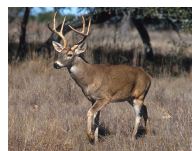
- At Cove Creek School...

- At Cove Creek School...
- Start at the big red tank next to the parking lot behind the school.
- Go towards the SOUTH, go around the left of the Greenhouse, past a gravel path.
- Around the small brick building, you will find a stack of "Legos" made of clay, that's where the pesky possum is hiding!
- Please return the Legos and the box to the way you found them.

THE DARTING DEER



At Cove Creek School...

- Go around the back of the school to a small brick building with a red tank attached to it, it's behind a greenhouse.
- Turn WEST.
- Walk towards a knocked down tree hovering above the ground. Look for the darting deer close to the tip of the log.
- Please re-hide the box afterwards.

- At Cove Creek School...
- Head towards the picnic shelter by the playground.
- At the picnic shelter, turn to face the stream.
- There is a small downhill and a flat grass path.
- Look for the beautiful bluebird hanging around the biggest boulder by the path, right before the woods.
